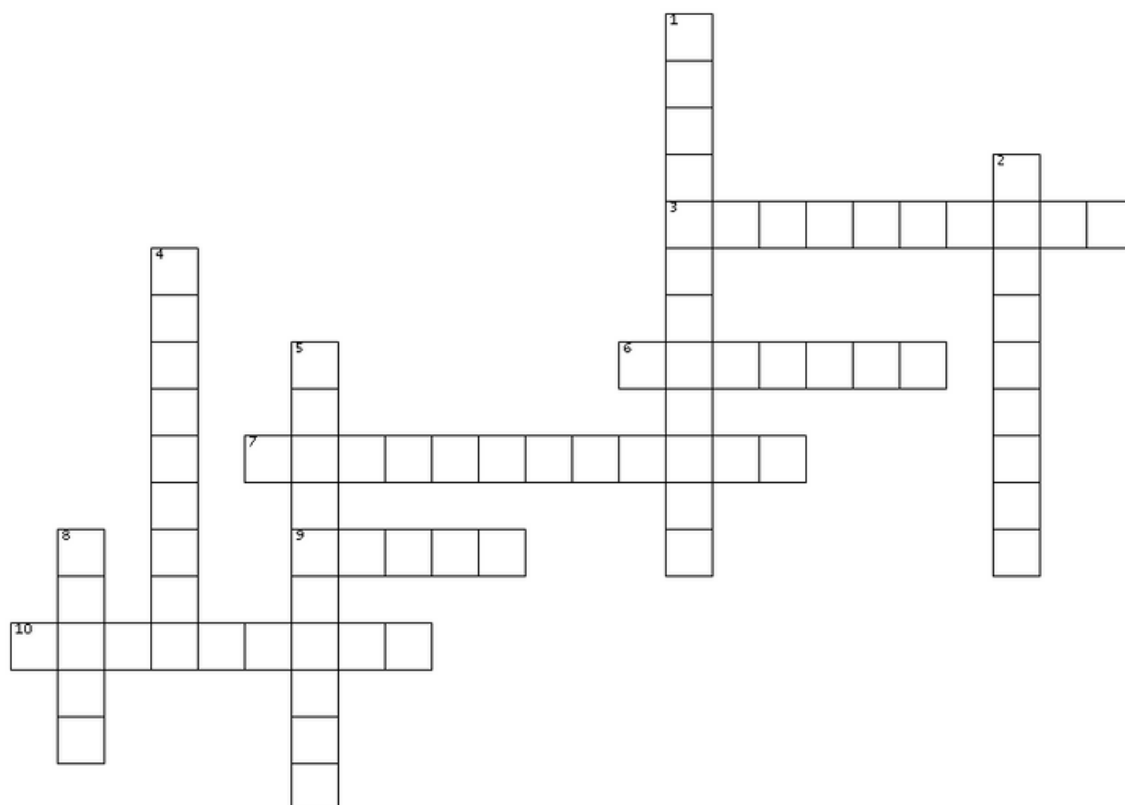


CROSS WORD
